The District- Francis Howell North, which is a suburban high school located in St. Charles County, Missouri, is one of three high schools in the Francis Howell School District. The District encompasses over 150 square miles in the southeast corner of St. Charles County and is one of the largest school districts in the State of Missouri. The cities within the District's boundaries include St. Peters, Cottleville, Weldon Spring, Harvester, New Melle, southern portions of St. Charles City, and eastern portions of O'Fallon. Residents work in a variety of professional, white-collar, skilled and semi-skilled occupations. Francis Howell School District's mission is to prepare students today for success tomorrow.

The High School- The 2020-2021 enrollment for Francis Howell North, home of the Knights, is 1704 students. It consists of grades 9-12 with a senior class of approximately 392 students. The faculty consists of 104 certified teachers; over 85% have earned at least a Master's degree. Nine teachers have their National Board Certification. The student-teacher ratio is 25:1 and the student-counselor ratio is 300:1. Francis Howell North High School holds membership in the Missouri Association of College Admission Counseling (MOACAC). We are also a member of the Lewis & Clark Career Center, participate in the Missouri A+ program, offer a business immersion program for juniors and seniors through our Center for Advanced Professional Studies (CAPS) curriculum and we partner with Saint Charles Community College (SCC) to offer the Early College Program which offers high school students an opportunity to earn transferable college credits while still enrolled in high school.

Curriculum- Francis Howell North offers a wide variety of courses and students are encouraged to take a strong academic program that will challenge their abilities and prepare them for post-secondary education. Over 170 courses are offered with honors levels in all core academic subjects and foreign language beyond level two. Students must meet specific criteria to be enrolled in honor classes.

Advanced Placement Program -

There are twenty-five Advanced Placement courses offered to students. Approximately twenty-five percent of the senior class took at least one Advanced Placement Exam. Of those seniors, Francis Howell North had 13 AP Scholars. Three AP Scholars were recognized with Honors while four received with Distinction.

Marking System- A = 100-90% B = 80-89% C = 70-79% D = 60-69% F = 59% or below

Class Rank: Class rank is based on grades earned in all subjects prorated according to the amount of credit offered for each course. The following grade scale is used: A=4 B=3 C=2 D=1 F=0

Honors and Advanced Placement courses are noted on the transcript & are offered in a variety of areas. The grading scale for these courses is: A=5 B=4 C=3 D=1 F=0

Class of 2020 Statistics- Of the 362 graduates, 55% plan to attend a four-year college and 35% plan to attend a two-year or vocational college.

ACT Results - The average ACT composite score for the 2019 graduates was 21.8, for 2020 it is TBD.

Scholarship Monies - The class of 2020 was offered approximately \$7,120,000 in scholarship monies. Twenty-five students were Bright Flight recipients and one student received National Merit honors.
